
Memphis-based Fogelman Management announces expansion in five states

Memphis-based Fogelman Management Group announced today it has been awarded nine new management contracts totaling nearly 2,300 units.

The move expands the company's presence in Colorado, Georgia, Missouri, Kansas and its home state of Tennessee.

The new apartment communities are: CityGreen at Northshore in Chattanooga (282 units); Georgetown Grove in Savannah, Ga. (168 units); Lexington Farms (404 units), Cambridge Square (408 units) and Villa Medici (166 units), all in Overland Park, Kan. (404 units); New Longview in Lee's Summit, Mo. (206 units); Dove Tree in Colorado Springs, Colo. (288 units); and Briar Club (272 units) and Cinnamon Trails (208 units), both in Memphis.

"These recent property additions are all located within current Fogelman Management Group markets and will assist us in our current goal of adding scale and gaining market share," said company president Mark Fogelman.

With these recent additions, Fogelman Management Group is now managing 20,300 apartment homes, valued at more than \$1.5 billion and located in 25 cities in 14 states.

The privately held company, founded in 1963, focuses exclusively on the operations of multifamily apartment communities.
