She studied photography at the Photography Portfolio Center in Atlanta, Georgia, and has assisted photographers Lisa Charles Watson and Ignacio Urquiza. In Mexico she exhibited in Escuela de Bellas Artes, Museo de Arte Siqueiros, and Casa de la Cultura de Tlalpan. In Texas her work has been exhibited in the Instituto de México and the Blue Star Gallery. Her work has been published in Time Magazine and *Grandes*.

In her artist statement for the exhibition *Hanging with Boys and Little Cloths*, Pauline Stevens states, "Boys can fill a room with deep intensity and joy. They are honest about their dreams and wishes. They are capable of becoming superheroes in an instant and become tired the very next. They make life bigger just by using every little source they can. It is like waking up to the way it should be. High moments of loud laughs and big dreams and low ones of frustration and good naps. In *Hanging with Boys*, you will share an afternoon with my sons."

Pauline Stevens continues, "It is easy to feel melancholic when we see our kids growing up. We tend to do scrapbooks, quilts and choose things that remind us of them as keepsakes. This collection is based on some of the little cloths my friends and I saved to remind us of our little ones."
