DALLAS – The Bath House Cultural Center presents **Layered Journeys**, an exhibition of exquisitely engaging abstract digital paintings by Jeanne Sturdevant. The exhibition will run from December 6, 2008 to January 3, 2009. An opening reception with the artist will be held on Saturday, December 6, 2008 from 7 to 9 pm. Both the exhibition and the reception are free and open to the public.

The exhibition alludes to life experiences, both real and imagined. Dreams, memories, and observations are transformed and interwoven as the artist's surreal images evolve. Sturdevant's organic sense of composition was honed as an art major at Texas Tech University and applied in various mediums during her long career as a studio artist, earning regional, national, and international recognition.

Sturdevant currently lives and works in Greenville, Texas. The artist earned a Bachelor of Science in Art Education and Master of Science in Art and Education degrees at Texas Tech University.
