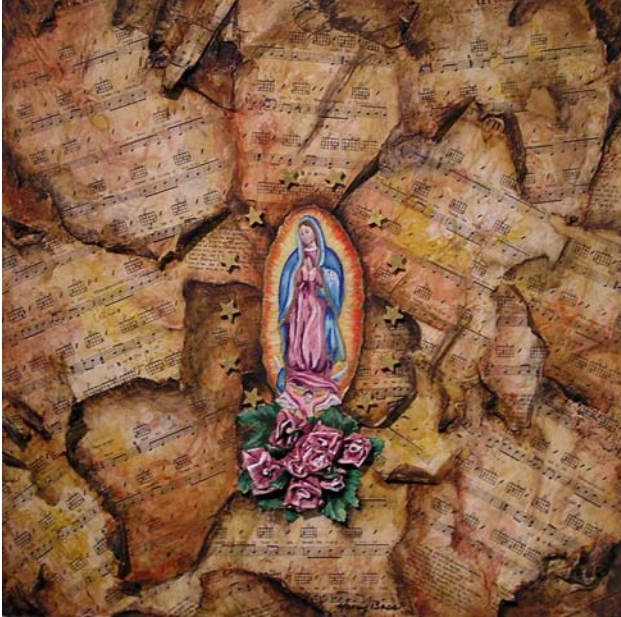
Location and hours
