## ***ONE THIRTY PRODUCTIONS ANNOUNCES CHRISTMAS PRODUCTION OF “GREETINGS”***

**DALLAS** (October 28, 2011) - One-Thirty Productions and the Bath House Cultural Center, in cooperation with the City of Dallas Office of Cultural Affairs, are thrilled to announce the opening of *Greetings* by Tom Dudzick, a Holiday show that is “a comic jewel” of a play. Dudzick is best known for his warm family comedies that have enchanted audiences across the country. He has a real ear for dialogue and characters that touch the heart.

*Greetings* is the hilarious, joy-filled story of Andy Gorski who brings his Jewish fiancé home to meet his Catholic parents and his mentally challenged younger brother on Christmas Eve.
