Strawberry Trifle for Mom

Ingredients

- 1 (5 ounce) package instant vanilla pudding mix
- 3 cups cold milk
- 1 (9 inch) angel food cake, cut in cubes
- 4 bananas, sliced
- 1 (16 ounce) package frozen strawberries, thawed
- 1 (12 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed



Directions

Prepare pudding with milk according to package directions. In a trifle bowl or other glass serving dish, layer half the cake pieces, half the pudding, half the bananas, half the strawberries and half the whipped topping. Repeat layers. Cover and chill in refrigerator 4 hours before serving.

A **United States federal holiday** observed on the last Monday (May 30 in 2011). Formerly known as Decoration Day, it commemorates U.S. soldiers who died while in the **military service**.^[1] First enacted to honor **Union** and **Confederate** soldiers following the **American Civil War**,^[2] it was extended after **World War I** to honor Americans who have died in all wars.

Memorial Day often marks the start of the **summer** vacation season, and **Labor Day** its end.

Begun as a ritual of remembrance and reconciliation after the Civil War, by the early 20th century, Memorial Day was an occasion for more general expressions of memory, as ordinary people visited the graves of their deceased relatives, whether they had served in the military or not. It also became a long weekend increasingly devoted to shopping, family get-togethers, fireworks, trips to the beach, and national media events such as the **Indianapolis 500** auto race, held since 1911 on the Sunday of Memorial Day
