Family Photo Strip for dad



Kids can make a fabulous gift to perfect for grandparents, parents, aunts or uncles! This project is easy to put together and looks very impressive hanging on the wall.

What you'll need:

- 3 family snapshots
- Craft foam: red, blue, yellow
- 6 feet wide ribbon
- Scissors
- White craft glue

How to make it:

1. Cut photos into 4"x4" squares.
2. Cut craft foam into 6"x6" squares.
3. Glue photos to craft foam squares.
4. Fold ribbon in half to create a 3 foot long strip.
5. Place foam squares upside down, making sure the photos are all facing in the same direction. Glue the ribbon to the back of the foam squares -- the first one should be 3 inches from the top of the ribbon. Glue the other squares 1 inch apart.
6. From the scraps of craft foam you had left over, cut a strip to cover the ribbon on the back of each square to reinforce.
